Here are the instructions explaining how to enroll:

Step 1. Go to the Quia website at <http://www.quia.com/web>.

Step 2. Now, click the area labeled *Students*. When the next page appears, enter your username and password if you already have a Quia account. If you do not have an account, click the link *Create my free account*. Fill out the form that appears. Select "Student" as the account type. When you are done, press the *Create my account* button.

Step 3. You should now be in the Student Zone. Type in the class code **XGDKJ676** in the text field and press the *Add class* button. Now you're done!

**Vocabulary activities...** make sure to include French accents. Moreover, all French nouns must have an article to indicate gender.

- c) Regular -re verbs (6)
- d) Irregular verbs (8)
- e) Les verbes réfléchis (8)

Les noms

- a) Les parties du corps (body parts)
- b) La toilette (personal hygiene)
- c) Les contes de fées (fairy tales)
- d) À la maison (household items)
- e) Les produits au magasin (products at the store)
- f) À la gare et à l'aéroport (at the train station and at the airport)
