## MVRHS 2018 Peer Outreach Retreat took place on 10/24 <u>& 10/25</u>

We have new Peer Leaders Trained at MVRHS! The primary goal of Peer Outreach is to tap into the informal helping network that already exists among students.



Students nominated peers they trust and those they will speak to about issues they might be having. The peer nomination process allows the program to have a broad list of students from different social circles. Nominated students (10 from each grade) took part in a two-day experiential learning retreat where they learned how to be better helpers to their friends. Day one focused on identifying pertinent issues they typically see with friends; learning active listening and communication skills: and what their limits are particularly when to go to an adult for help. Day two focused on putting these skills into practice and learning healthy self care options. The retreat was co-facilitated by senior members of the program and staff members.
