- **FAMILY ID is MVRHS's** streamlined approach to entering & verifying data for annual Student Registration/ Medical Information and Sports Clearance.
 - o All Parents/Guardians must enter their student's data into FAMILY ID
 - If you have a current MVRHS student, you will have an existing account. If not, simply go to FAMILY ID https://www.familyid.com/organizations/marthas-vineyard-regional to create your parent/guardian account. Fill out required sections: Student Registration & Permissions, Medical Information, and Sports Clearance (If your child plays a sport.) You may also access the link through www.mvrhs.org
- **Power School, Google Classroom**, and **School Messenger** are also important communication tools used at MVRHS for parents, guardians, and students.
